Dear Parents/Guardians,

Your child participates in a program called iPass (also referred to as iLearn) during their math class period one hour per week. We wanted to let you know that this program is available online at www.ilearnmath.com and can be done anywhere that your child has access to a computer and internet. Your child will need to use the same username and password that he/she uses at school to log-in.

About the Program

iPASS stands for an "Individual Prescription for Achieving State Standards," which reflects two of its most important features:

- 1. It is prescriptive at a very detailed level that is, instruction is matched to the specific concept and skill deficits of individual students.
- 2. It is mastery-based, which means students achieve mastery of each standard as a prerequisite for progress through the program.

It is a fully-automated, web-based math curriculum and instruction system that provides individualized instruction to meet the identified needs of each student. The curriculum is highly aligned with the recommendations of the National Math Advisory Panel and covers all the core concepts necessary for success in elementary grades, middle grades as well as Algebra or Integrated Math in High School.
